I am pleased to send you this letter of endorsement from the United Natural Products Alliance (UNPA) in support of the new American Herbal Products Association initiative, the *Guidance on Good Agricultural and Collection Practices and Good Manufacturing Practices for Botanical Materials* (GACP-GMP).

UNPA is confident that this comprehensive guidance and its accompanying assessment tools will help promote proper identification of and reduce the adulteration of botanical raw materials, with a goal of providing high-quality ingredients for dietary supplements and other natural health products. The guidance serves as a standard for the entire botanical supply chain, specifically growers and processors, and has the potential to ably serve end-use supplement consumers.

Along with the creation of a new best-practices standard for the growing, sourcing and processing of botanical materials, the assessment tools, covering cultivation, wildcrafting, harvesting, post-harvesting, processing and recommendations for dietary ingredient suppliers, provide a clear road map for how to achieve the good manufacturing practices outlined in the guidance.
