- 10 military installation, only if the dietary supplement has
- 11 been verified by an independent third party for recognized
- 12 public standards of identity, purity, strength, and com-
- 13 position, and adherence to related process standards.

- 21 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 22 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date that is one
- 23 year after the date of the enactment of this Act, and shall
- 24 apply with respect to sales that occur on or after such
